Short Term Routine Medication

(e.g. antibiotics)

Short term routine medication is medication that is required routinely for the short-term treatment of an acute condition e.g. one course of antibiotics to treat infection

You do not need to provide additional documentation to prove the medication is medically necessary as long as the pharmacy label matches the prescription from the medical practitioner.

Documentation required:

1. A completed consent to administer medication form (DOCX, 106KB) for each medication

Medication:

- Must be in its original packaging
- Must have a pharmacy label attached

Guidelines:

- At completion of the administration period, unused medication needs to be collected from the Main Admin (B Block) or Student Services (N Block)..
- Please advise office staff if the medication needs to be kept in the fridge.
- Please provide any spoons/syringes/measuring cups required for dispensing the medication.
