Please see below for an update about WESS activities.

These decisions have been made after careful consideration and with all the information available. They have been made with our student and staff health and wellbeing at the centre.

The decisions below pertain to activities for this term and are in addition to yesterday's communication.

WESS Classroom Music program.

From our Music Coordinator:

Our program involves students using shared instruments throughout the day. This means up to 200 students are touching ukuleles, mallets, percussion instruments on a daily basis. It is not practical to wipe down each instrument between classes and allow to dry. Therefore, to minimise contact, we will be altering our program until the end of the term. We will provide other engaging music learning activities that will not involve multiple students touching and sharing instruments.

Choirs

Ensembles and bands cancelled for rest of term, but lessons will continue. *Tara Neal is looking at the possibility of some of the bands rehearsing in Dirram Yani next week, where students can spread out. Parents will be notified via email if this goes ahead.

Swimming Lessons

At this stage swimming lessons will go ahead. We have spoken at length with our pool works provider and they have documentation in direct response to the coronavirus, which outlines the proactive steps they are taking with both chemicals and additional cleaning. Ms T and Mrs Geddes are also being proactive with the way students are changing and they are using strategies to stagger this so that there are fewer students at a time.

All of this considered, the PE teachers respect that some parents/carers will still not feel comfortable and there will be no consequence if parents/carers send a note excusing students from swimming class.
