Dear WESS Families

On Monday, 11th May we are excited to welcome our Prep and Year 1 students back to WESS. They will join the children of essential workers from Year 2-6.

Please note that until all students return to school, we will operate on the Junior Timetable – 8:45am – 3:00pm.

On-site Health and Safety Measures

We will continue to implement strict hygiene measures at school, recommended by QLD Health and the Department of Education (DOE), such as:

- Regular handwashing and hand sanitising, particularly before and after eating. Many families are
 opting to send small bottles of sanitiser with their children for personal use. We encourage this
 initiative as a supplement to our existing processes.
- Increased cleaning of classrooms
- Regular cleaning of equipment and materials
- Encouraging students to bring their own water bottles for personal use
- Asking students not to share food
- Avoiding large gatherings at school such as assemblies
- Separating year level play areas
- Keeping doors open to minimise touchpoints
- Cancelling any excursions, camps, interschool sports etc
- Reminding parents/carers not to send children who are sick or have compromised immune systems to school.

Adult Physical Distancing

Physical distancing for adults remains in place. We are limiting access to the school grounds by non-essential visitors, parents and carers.

We therefore ask for your support with the following:

- Please do not gather in the school grounds before and after school. (See new Drop Off and Pick-Up Procedure below)
- Do not go to the classrooms. If you need to speak to a teacher, please do so by phone or email.
- Use online payment methods where possible
- Adhere to the 1.5m social distancing rule at all times



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Drop off and Pick up for Prep and Year 1 Students - NEW PROCEDURE

Drop off:

- Prep and Year 1 students arrive at school **from 8.15am**. (NB Any student arriving before this time should access OSHC)
- They are to access the school grounds via the gate in the prep area, located on Hardgrave Rd.
- Students will be met at the gate by staff members and directed to their classrooms (Prep) and the prep sandpit area (Year 1).
- Parents/carers are asked to drop and go. They are not permitted in the Prep area or classrooms.

We are hoping that this new process will reduce the likelihood of adults congregating in areas within the school grounds.

Pick up:

In the afternoon parents/carers are asked to **collect students from the oval anytime from 2.45pm**, where they will be sitting in their class groups with their classroom teachers.

Once you have collected your children we ask that you leave the school grounds immediately.
