ACTIVITY	Completed? (Please Tick)
<b>1 Check your iPad meets Specifications.</b> Check that your child's iPad is 2021 iPad 8th, 9th or 10th Gen (64GB minimum), Wi-Fi, capable of running iOS 17. <b>Erase all content and settings on pre-owned iPads before beginning this checklist. Remove the SIM card if there is one installed.</b>	
<b>2 Create a student Apple ID</b> It is mandatory that the iPad is set up using your <b>child's own Apple ID</b> by creating a new iCloud email with a variation of their name. This is established through Family Sharing. Please <b>do not setup the iPad with a shared parent Apple ID.</b> We advise that you do not tell your child the Apple ID/Password. Correctly creating your child's own Apple ID will ensure that they are only accessing age-appropriate Apps and content in the App Store and Safari.	
<b>3 Set up Family Sharing</b> Family Sharing makes it easy for up to six people in your family to share each other's iTunes, Books and App Store purchases without sharing accounts. <a href="#">How Family Sharing works -Apple Support - YouTube</a>	
<b>4 Digitally name your child's iPad</b> Name your child's iPad with their name - Settings >General > About > Name	
<b>5 Name your child's Accessories</b> Protective Case with Keyboard, Headphones, Stylus etc.	
<b>6 Add a Lock Screen Passcode</b> iPads must have a lock screen passcode. Use thumb print (or touch ID) or facial recognition (face ID). <b>A 6 Digit passcode is required for Intune Company Portal.</b> <a href="#">How to change your passcode on your iPad</a>	
<b>7 Add a Lock Screen photo of your child's face</b> Adding a photo to the Lock Screen: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Take a photo of your child using the Camera App.</li> <li>2 Tap the "Settings" icon on your iPad's home screen to launch the Settings App. Tap "Wallpaper" and then tap "Choose a new wallpaper."</li> <li>3 Select "Camera Roll" and select the photo of your child Select "Select Set Lock Screen"</li> <li>4 Close the Settings App.</li> </ol>	
<b>8 Download Intune Company Portal App</b> Install and sign in by entering your child's EQ email, EQ MIS ID and password. Follow this DoE how to guide: <a href="#">Intune – iOS enrolment video - Youtube.com</a> <div style="text-align: right;">  </div> <p>Company portal provides:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Access to the school's secure network</li> <li>• Access to the full app list that students will use at school.</li> </ul> <p>Please Install the following essential apps: Microsoft Word, Excel, Powerpoint, OneNote, OneDrive, Teams, Notability, SeeSaw, Switch4Schools and WhoAmI. <i>Other apps will be downloaded with teachers when necessary. They are not required to install during Onboarding.</i></p>

<b>9 Download Book Creator App</b> Book Creator is available on the App Store for \$5.99. This will require credit card details that can be deleted as soon as installation is complete. 	
<b>10 Organise School Apps</b> Drag all school apps so they sit on their own page. These include the essential apps outlined in Step 8 and Book Creator in Step 9.	
<b>11 Enable – Dictation and Predictive Text</b> Go to Settings > General > Keyboards > Enable Dictation Go to Settings > General > Keyboards > Predictive	
<b>12 Set your iPad language to English</b> Go to Settings > General > Language & Region > iPad Language	
<b>13 Enable - Dictionary</b> Go to Settings > General > Dictionary > English (UK)	
<b>14 Enable - Multitasking Gestures</b> Go to Settings > Home Screen & Dock > Multitasking and Gestures (select each function to green)	
<b>15 Enable - Speak Selection</b> Go to Settings > Accessibility > Spoken Content > Speak Selection (Slide to green = on)	
<b>16 Set up Content and Privacy Restrictions</b> Go to Settings> Screen Time> Content & Privacy Restrictions> (slide to green = on) Web Content> Limit Adult Websites (tick) This keeps internet searches safe at home, as the school internet filters for safe content. Continue adjusting restrictions as you choose. These are a few settings we recommend you turn on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• iTunes and App Store Purchases &gt; Require Passcode &gt; Always Require (tick)</li> <li>• Content Restrictions &gt;</li> <li>• Music, Podcasts, News and Workouts&gt; Clean</li> <li>• Music videos &gt; off</li> <li>• Music profiles &gt; off</li> <li>• Movies &gt; G or Don't Allow</li> <li>• TV Shows &gt; G or Don't Allow</li> <li>• Books &gt; Clean</li> <li>• Apps &gt; 9+</li> <li>• App Clips &gt; Don't Allow</li> </ul>	
<b>17 Add School Focus</b> Go to Settings > Focus > Set up new focus by pressing the “+” > Custom > name “School” > Customise Focus > Allow Notifications > No people or apps should be selected Customise Home Screen by choosing the page with learning apps Set a Schedule > Mon- Friday 8:00am – 3:00pm For support: <a href="#">How to use Focus on your iPhone (Works for iPads)   Apple Support - YouTube</a>	
<b>18 Go to QParents (External Link)</b> Ensure you have granted permissions to use required apps. This is mandatory and will allow parents/carers to securely access their child’s information.
